Sheikh Abdul Awal, J:

In this writ petition the petitioner calls in question the legality a propriety of the impugned order dated 21.06.1999 passed by the learned 2nd Court of Settlement, Segunbagicha, Dhaka in Settlement Case No. 8 of 1999 rejecting the settlement case on the ground of limitation.

Mr. Md. Khurshid Alam Khan, the learned Advocate appearing for the petitioner could not produce any relevant document to show the ownership of the petitioner in the suit land. On a query from the Court he simply submits that he is not in a position to contact with his client-petitioner as this Rule was obtained long back on 30.03.2000 and at present he fails to know the whereabouts of the petitioner. Finally, the learned Advocate referring a decision reported in 42 DLR (AD) 86 submits that an order may kindly be passed as per law.

Having heard the learned Advocate for the petitioner, perused the writ petition and other materials on record.

On scrutiny of the record, we find nothing on record to suggest that the petitioner has any right, title and possession over case land.

Considering the facts and circumstance of the case together with cited decision, we find no merit in this Rule.

In the result, the Rule is discharged.
