The instant Rule arises out of the judgment and order dated 11.08.2022 passed by the learned Joint District Judge, 2nd Court, Meherpur in Miscellaneous Appeal No. 03 of 2020 dismissing the appeal and thereby affirming the judgment and order dated 16.01.2020 passed by the Senior Assistant Judge, Meherpur in Title Suit No. 65 of 2008.

At the time of issuance of the Rule, this Court on 02.01.2023 passed an ad-interim order directing the parties to maintain *status quo* in respect of possession and position of the suit land for a period of 03 months which was extended time to time and lastly the period of *status quo* was extended till disposal of the appeal.

The present opposite parties as plaintiffs filed the suit for eviction and recovery of khas possession of the suit land. During the pendency of the suit, the plaintiffs obtained an order of temporary injunction from the trial Court whereby the defendants were restrained from entering into the schedule land illegally and from constructing a pucca structure or changing the nature of the land by cutting earth till disposal of the suit. The order of injunction was affirmed by the appellate Court below. Challenging the same, the defendants filed the instant revisional application, obtained the Rule and order of *status quo*.

Heard the learned Advocates of both sides and perused the materials on record.

Considering the facts and circumstances of the case, I am of the view that the order of *status quo* passed by this Court at the time of issuance of the Rule, if continues till disposal of the

suit, will serve justice. Accordingly, the parties are directed to maintain *status quo* till disposal of the suit.

With the above observations and directions, the Rule is disposed of.
