**Farah Mahbub, J:**

Today, the matter has appeared in the list for order.

Mr. Md. Ashikur Rahman, the learned Advocate appearing for the petitioner submits that pursuant to the interim direction so given by this Hon'ble Court at the time of issuance of the Rule on 05.02.2024, the Tribunal concerned has meanwhile disposed of the application so made by the petitioner on 04.12.2024 towards release of the consignment in question vide order dated

19.02.2024 in Appeal Case No.(Cus) 635/2023. Under the circumstances, he prays for passing necessary order.
